

FLOOD SAFETY

4 simple steps to securing your gas cylinder during heavy rain and when a flood is imminent. Be prepared and BE SAFE.

TIPS

1. Ensure that your cylinder is always stored and kept in an upright position.

2. If flooding is imminent, ensure to secure your cylinder properly - even full cylinders will float.

3. If storing your cylinder, make sure to disconnect the regulator, turn the valve off and cover the mouth of the cylinder to avoid water getting inside.

4. After the storm or flood has passed, make sure that your regulator is dry before reconnecting it or using your cylinder again.
